



PROTECTING RELIGIOUS FREEDOM

Your National Statesman has reported a number of instances in which public schools and/or local governmental units have practiced religious discrimination. One of these was a case in which a Jewish synagogue was the target. The other instances have been when Christians felt the sting of official bigotry.

The good news is that many Christians are no longer willing to accept these official instances of bigotry such as when communities, which allow Jewish Menorahs to be displayed, ban Christmas manger scenes.

Several private legal organizations have sprung up, such as the Christian Law Association, which provide free legal assistance to Christian individuals and institutions whose religious liberty is threatened by humanist public officials.

In the 2005-2006 election cycle the beer, wine and liquor industry interests gave more than ten million dollars to candidates for the U.S. House and Senate.

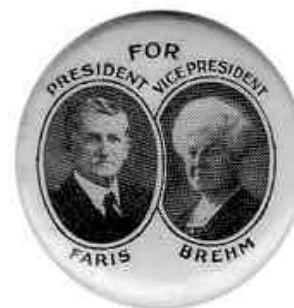

AMERICA THREATENED BY AMNESTY

During 1995-2000 (Clinton administration) the U.S. Justice Civil Rights Divisions conducted one review and no investigations of religious bias complaints. By contrast, from 2001-2006 (Bush administration) the department reviewed 82 cases and opened 40 investigations in religious discrimination cases involving educational institutions alone.

When I attended school in a Massachusetts city with a religious breakdown or about 40% Protestant, 40% Roman Catholic and 20% Jewish, we began each day with the reading of a Psalm and the recitation, by those wishing to do so, of the Lord's Prayer. There were no religion-inspired fights over

this practice and each student was reminded briefly that we were accountable to the Creator from whom our Founding Fathers said our rights were derived.

The U.S. Supreme Court gave its approval to a ban on such activity. One result: in schools where chewing gum, cutting a class or whispering during class were the main behavior problems, today's scene includes classes for pregnant students, police and/or metal detectors to keep guns, knives and bombs out of the building.

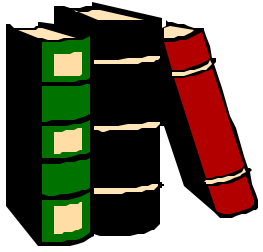

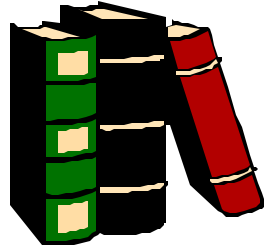
May each of us speak out when we see any tax-supported entity seeking to suppress religion in the public square.

THREE BELIEVE

ALCOHOL POISONING KILLS STUDENT

Jordan Crist, 19 years old, was found unconscious in his dormitory room at Southern Methodist University. He later died and the coroner's official verdict was death by alcohol poisoning. The Dallas Morning News Reported that the student from Hinsdale, Texas had a blood alcohol level that was five times the legal limit.

Note: He died of alcohol poisoning. No one dies of orange juice poisoning, potato poisoning or beef poisoning. Why? They are not poisonous. Ethyl alcohol is poisonous. If one drank a glassful straight they would die. The only reason alcohol users do not die each time they imbibe is that the alcohol is heavily diluted with water and other ingredients. Obviously, this young man's body had not yet built up sufficient tolerance to handle the amount of alcohol he ingested. Every year, in our Denver area, there are accounts of young people dying this way.

Centuries ago, in a heavily drinking society, one of Shakespeare's characters asks "Oh, that men would put a poison to their mouth to steal their brain away".

MODEST USE OF ALCOHOL GROWS CANCERS IN MICE

Researcher Jian-Wei Gu of the University of Mississippi and his colleagues conducted a four-week study in which mice were ingested with breast cancer cells. Some were then ingested with the equivalent of two alcoholic drinks per day. All mice developed tumors but the size of the tumors in the mice fed alcohol were twice as large as in those mice not so fed.

Women cannot avoid genetic risks for cancer but they can avoid the added risk of breast cancer which comes with alcohol consumption.

BUS DRIVER DRINKS AND KILLS ONE, INJURING EIGHT

The Chicago Tribune of May 24, 2007 reported on a school bus crash, which killed one man and injured eight others. The driver, whom witnesses said drove at speeds up to 70 miles per hour, had a blood-alcohol level of .225, nearly three times the legal limit. He admitted to drinking shots of whiskey and a full six-pack of beer before starting to drive. He crashed the bus into a Ford Explorer SUV at a speed of between 50-70 miles per hour.

While some national reports indicate 40% or more of vehicle fatalities are due to alcohol consumption, professional driving organizations and coroners have placed the figure at closer to 80%. Frequently, if only the drunk driver is killed, local police report heart failure or some other malady as being responsible in order to spare the deceased's family further pain and embarrassment.

Sadly most judges and juries are relatively lenient when sentencing those who kill with a vehicle when drunk. The victims of drunk drivers are just as dead or seriously injured as those assaulted with a gun or knife. Drunk drivers may not intend to kill or maim but they know that alcohol can cause that to happen and they still choose to take that risk.

Drunks drivers who kill or maim should be put in prison for many years to deter others from doing likewise
